Field Technicians to Participate in Fishery Surveys

An environmental firm in Lafayette CA that specializes in conducting marine fisheries surveys is hiring seasonal part-time technicians. Technicians will have the opportunity to gain first hand fieldwork experience collecting and identifying fishes and invertebrates. The positions give employees the opportunity to interact with other technicians and biologist at a professional level.

Job Description:

The job involves sampling in the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta, the San Francisco Bay and the Pacific Ocean and requires traveling to the sampling sites. A valid Drivers License is required. Employees will be required to work during the daytime and at night. Sampling is conducted either from shore or by small boat at both remote locations and industrial areas. Some of the sampling techniques include using plankton nets, fyke nets, intertidal surveys, and scuba. Employees will be expected to operate machinery used to aid in sampling efforts. Successful candidates should be also able to work in the laboratory using microscopes. This work is performed under a quality assurance program and therefore requires attention to detail. We will provide training to qualified individuals. Schedules may be somewhat flexible to allow students the opportunity to gain job experience.
